

James P. Covell Nature Preserve

Approximately 2727 County Road 52, Auburn IN, 46706

ACREAGE: 96 | ACQUIRED: 2014

This preserve protects 2,700 feet of Cedar Creek's west bank. The property was donated by Dr. Jack Covell, who wanted to see his late brother's land preserved for the animals that live here—wild turkey, great blue heron, belted kingfisher, mink, otter and many more.

The property includes 40 acres of recently planted trees, 33 acres of emerging upland forest and 23 acres of mature forested floodplain. Several trees in the preserve are estimated to be more than 150 years old.
